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YEAR 7 SWIMMING TRIAL & POOL ACTIVITY DAY 2018

Dear Parents/Carers,

Taree High School will be running their annual swimming carnival on Friday 9 February 2018 at Manning Aquatic and Leisure Centre. It is a whole school carnival and it is expected that all students attend. To prepare for this carnival Year 7 will be going to the pool on **Friday 2 February 2018** to assess their swimming competency over 50m, then they will participate in activities for the rest of the day at the pool. For those students who need to build their skill and confidence we will be trying to provide a learn to swim and stroke correction program which will be held each Wednesday during sport time for Term 1 if the number of students permit. A carnival information note will be sent home with your year 7 student week 1 2018. ALL year 7 students are to attend but, **if your child is a non-swimmer OR is unable to swim on Friday 2/2 morning, due to illness or injury, please complete the bottom of this form and have your child hand it in to the supervising teacher on their bus. They will still need to pay for their bus fare and pool entry.** If your child is participating but has a medical condition, please fill out the appropriate section and have your child also return it on the day.

Details for Friday 2 February:

- Students will go to roll call then meet in the main quad when the bell goes for the start of period 1
- They will then be directed to the top gate for bus allocation
- Students will be at the pool all day. 9.30am – 11.30am swim assessment. 11.30am - 2.45pm activities

Cost: Students will need a total of **\$11.00**

\$3.00 will be paid directly to the bus driver and

\$8.00 will be paid at the pool entry gate

Students who have a season swim pass may use this on the day BUT will also need to pay an extra \$4.80 for the pool activities.

Uniform: Students must wear their normal school uniform with appropriate shoes

Gear: Students will need swimmers, towel, hat, goggles if they have them, water and a plastic bag for wet gear. Sunscreen will be provided and students will be reminded to repeatedly apply the lotion

Lunch & Recess: Students are encouraged to bring healthy food on the day but the pool kiosk will also be open
